DUMPING OF CAR BODIES

To dump car bodies all tyres, LPG tanks, loose upholstery, rubbish, drainage bungs, fuel and oils need to be removed from the car prior to dumping. Failure to comply with this will incur additional cost.

MATERIALS ACCEPTED AS RECYCLING

Properly prepaired recycling material can be dropped off for FREE at the Karamea Transfer and Recycling Facility 😓

Cardboard is disposed of as refuse at the standart refuse charges in Karamea.

Only plastics #1, #2 and #5 are recyclable. They need to be rinsed, clean and lids off 🛟 💯

Aluminium tins and cans are recyclable. They need to be rinsed, and cleaned 👍

☑ Oil, transmission fluids and hydraulics (they must be clean and dropped off in containers no larger than 20 litres)

The following items might be accpeted if arranged with the site operator for FREE.

- **Wood**
- Paint
- **Corrugated iron**

If you are unsure wheather your waste can be disposed of at this facility please contact the site operator.

The site operator may be able to advise you on alternative disposal options that are not available at this facility.

WHAT IS NOT ACCEPTED FOR DISPOSAL

- X Grease fish or meat waste
- X Asbestos coatings and solvents
- X Resin bitumen products
- **X** Glue acids ∕ alkalis (eg lime)
- X Medical waste explosive materials
- X Caustic waste animal carcasses
- X Chemical / industrial sludges pathological waste
- X Demolition material (eg concrete and hardfill)
- X Any poisons as defined in the toxic substance regulations
- X Any hazardous substances as defined in the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996.
- X Any other chemicals whether in liquid or powder form
- X Agricultural or industrial products in sealed drums or otherwise.
- X Waste generated from mining operations which may contain hazardous components.
